New Year's Resolutions for Church Etiquette

From Father Stephen

- 1) Genuflecting :: Giving a genuflection of the right knee—or a profound bow for those physically unable—to the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle before sitting in the pew and at the end of mass before leaving the pew.
- 2) Restrooms :: Aside from real emergencies or other obvious exceptions (small children, those with medical issues, etc.), avoiding casually using bathrooms during Mass in order to stay focused on the liturgy, i.e. going before it starts or after it ends.
- 3) Punctuality :: Arriving before Mass to allow time for prayer or restroom use—this is especially needed for the 10:30 Mass; nearly one fifth of the congregation arrives each week after 10:30. Arriving late happens to everyone once in a while (especially for those who have small children), but we should avoid making it chronic.
- 4) Talking in the nave :: At the end of mass, out of respect for the Blessed Sacrament, avoiding talking with other parishioners in the main church space and waiting until the vestibule to visit.
