## Good Friday, April 18th, is a day of abstinence and fasting

- <u>Abstinence</u> (for <u>Catholics</u> <u>14 and over</u>) is defined as refraining from eating the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl.
- <u>Fasting</u> (for <u>Catholics 18-59</u>) is defined as one normal size meal in the course of the day plus two smaller sized meals that, when added together, are still less than the normal meal.
- Those who are ill, pregnant, or nursing are not obligated to fast, but they are still to observe abstinence.
