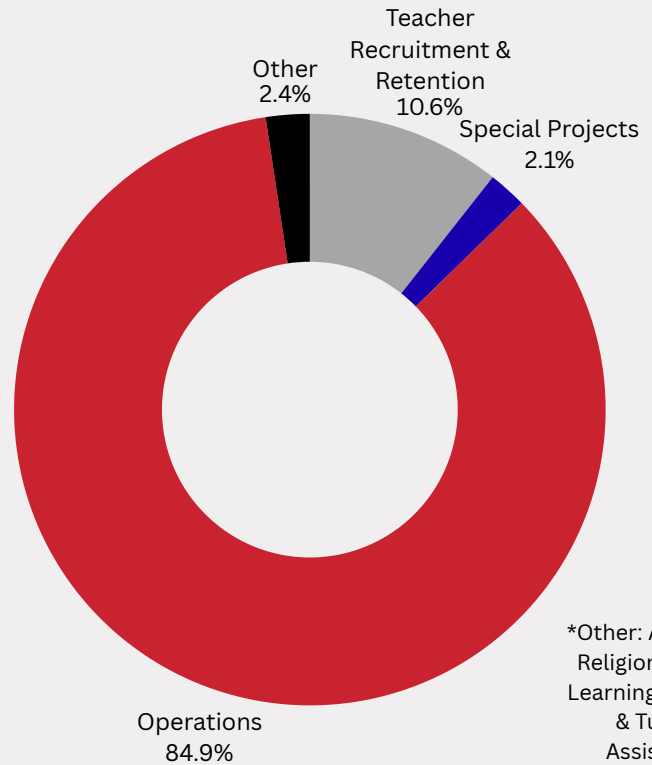

Investment Governance & Endowment Fund Management

The Sacred Heart Catholic School Endowment Fund (SHCSEF) was originally founded in 1986 for the sole purpose of supporting the needs of the Sacred Heart Catholic School in Morrilton, AR, the singular beneficiary of the SHCSEF. The SHCSEF is governed by a Board of Trustees who endeavor to effectively supervise, monitor, and evaluate the management of the Endowment’s investment portfolio. The Board partners with external asset managers and advisors from Stephens, Inc. to implement an Investment Policy Statement that is designed to grow the endowment, providing annual returns that keep pace with inflation while minimizing risk and volatility.

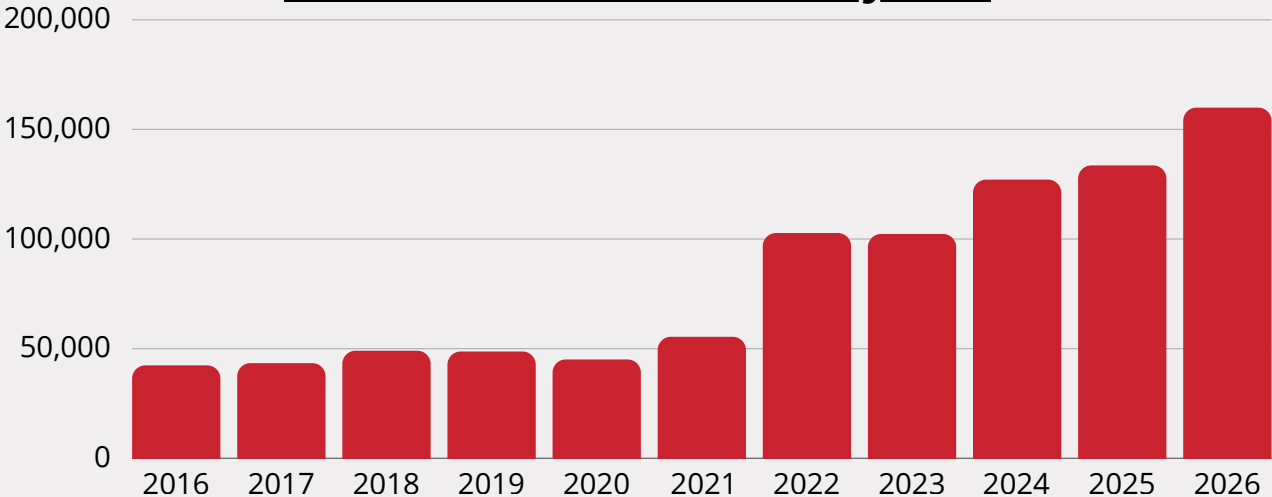
Endowment Distributions

The SHCSEF Distribution policy states that the Endowment Board may elect to distribute funds to the school annually. The Trustees have chosen to distribute 4% of the fund based on a 3-year rolling average of the December 31 account balance.

Since 2002, the school has received \$1,072,556 from the Endowment for operations; this supports the school's operating budget and represents an average of 5% of the total operating revenue for the school each year. In 2025-2026, the school received \$159,938 from the Endowment for:

- \$127,182 for operating costs and
- \$32,756 for other restricted projects

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Sacred Heart tuition assistance is available to families who qualify based on financial need. The following funds make an annual distribution to the tuition assistance fund.



Carl & Christine Thines Fund for Tuition Assistance - Distributed to date: \$5,528

Established by Felix & Mary Catherine Moix in 2012, in honor of her parents, for the purpose of providing tuition assistance to families who need it. 2026 Distribution: \$556.16



Ellen Hutchison Tuition Assistance Memorial Fund - Distributed to date: \$3,237

A scholarship fund to honor the memory of Ellen Hutchison, SH class of '83, was established by family and friends following her death, at age 20, in 1986. In 2020, the fund was rededicated as the Ellen Hutchison Tuition Assistance Memorial Fund with the Sacred Heart Catholic School Endowment Fund. 2026 Distribution: \$1,095.71



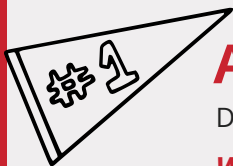
Meyer Family Memorial Fund in Memory of Patrick Merlyn Meyer: New in 2022

Distributions may be allocated for existing athletic or extracurricular programs at Sacred Heart.

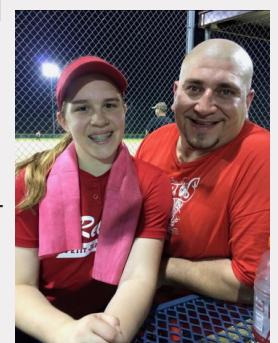
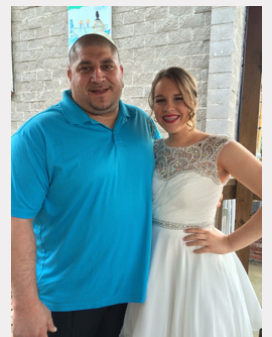


William "Bubba" Voliva Memorial Fund - New in 2025

The William "Bubba" Voliva Memorial Fund was created in 2020 and endowed in 2025 by Madison Harper ('20) and Mandy Perry to commemorate Madison's stepdad, Bubba, who passed away January of 2020. Bubba was an avid fan of his stepdaughter and supported her throughout all her schooling while at Sacred Heart. You could often find him helping out in the concession stand during basketball games, serving spaghetti at dinners, and happily manning the dunk tank at Bazaar, but his favorite place to be was out at the softball fields.

Whether he was playing catcher during pitching lessons, coaching the "lil Rebels" for his girl and her friends, or simply cheering on the Sacred Heart softball team during the spring season, he loved to be out at the fields, cheering loudly, and showing his support.

When available, an annual award will be made from this fund to the softball and baseball teams to help with getting new equipment or other projects that will assist with the training and development of skills. Through this award, we will honor Bubba's memory and his love for Sacred Heart athletics.





INVESTING IN TECHNOLOGY

Technology costs represent a significant portion of any annual school budget. Each year, this fund provides funds for new computers, security upgrades, etc.



The Jeff Maus ('84) Memorial Fund - Distributed to date: \$32,209

Established by the Maus and Hartman families in 2019, the fund honors the memory of Jeff Maus by providing an annual distribution for the technology needs at Sacred Heart. 2026 Distribution: \$9,254.29



TEACHER RECRUITMENT & RETENTION

Provides an annual bonus each summer for teachers based on years of service and percentage of the salary pool. Teachers received an average of \$635 in the summer of 2025.

Established in 2022 by Raymond ('81) and Kathy Dold, the fund supports the school's Special Learning Services Program. 2026 Distribution: \$517.16

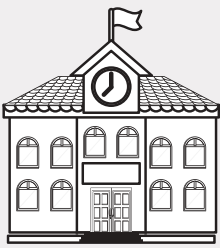


Hubert ('44) & Louise (Zimmerman, '49) Dold Fund - First Distribution: \$491.93
