Sacred Heart will honor this feast with a Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession. We will have a special celebratory mass at 5:00 pm on Sunday, June 22, followed by the Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession around the church/school campus and through the local neighborhood.
