**CORPUS CHRISTI CELEBRATION** The Feast of Corpus Christi, the weekend of June 22, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. Sacred Heart will honor this feast with a Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession. We will have a special celebratory mass at 5:00 pm on Sunday, June 22, followed by the Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession around the church/school campus and through the local neighborhood. Father will process with the monstrance, stopping to worship at altars on the way. Our First Communicants will lead the procession, and we invite all parishioners to join in. We pray for a large turnout to this event as we show our reverence to the source and summit of our Catholic faith, the Holy Eucharist. Please wear comfortable shoes for walking and, in case of rain, bring an umbrella. # Corpus Christi Procession

## June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, special 5 p.m. mass

### What to bring:

- Umbrella (to keep the sun off) or a hat
- Spray bottle to keep cool.
- Bottled water will be provided at the beginning and throughout the route.

### What to expect at the end:

- Reentering the church, we will have a short period of adoration, followed by solemn benediction.
- After benediction, join us in the church vestibule/outside under the portico for some food!

### In the event of rain:

- The procession will be canceled, but we will still have a period of adoration at the end of mass followed by ice cream in the church's vestibule and under the portico.

### Let us pray:

- Asking the intercession of Our Lady and St. Margaret Mary Alacoque that *God may bless us with cool weather and no rain.*
- Asking God that this event may stoke an ever greater love and appreciation of the Eucharist in the hearts of all the faithful
- Asking God that He bless all the needs of our local community.
