Our mass for **All Saints' Mass** will be Saturday, November 1st at 9 a.m. It is not a holy day of obligation in 2025. Many of you may remember in September 2024 when the Holy See's Dicastery for Divine Worship responded to a 'dubia' [a doubt] from several US bishops about holy days of obligation that fall on Saturdays or Mondays; the response gave the impression that even on those days, attending mass is obligatory. This past spring, however, the Holy See clarified that, apart from Christmas, this only applies to a country's patronal feast day, which for us in the U.S. is December 8th. Other holy days that fall on a Saturday or Monday--like November 1st this year--remain solemnities but are not holy days of obligation.
