33 Days to Morning Glory Marian Consecration At Home Retreat ~ January 9 - February 11

Join us for an at-home Marian Consecration retreat beginning January 9, 2026, and concluding on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on February 11, 2026. Marian consecration is a consecration to Jesus through Mary. Saint John Paul II described his own consecration as a "turning point" in his life. This retreat focuses on the teachings of 4 Marian experts, St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Mother Teresa, St. John Paul II, and St. Louis de Montfort. 
