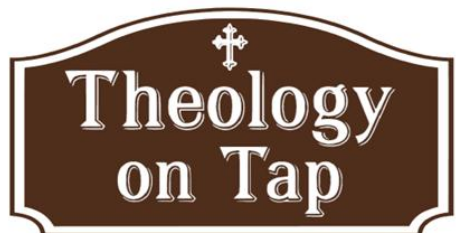

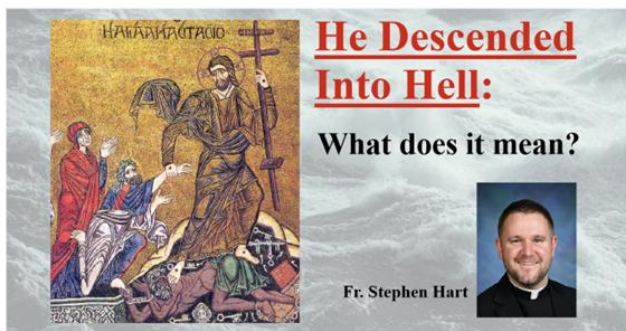

### **Father Stephen's comments on Church security - Sept 20th/21st**

As I mentioned I would two weeks ago, today I want to tell you all about a few things regarding our safety here at the weekend masses.

This time a year ago, we were just starting up our rotation of scheduled ushers at our masses for the first time since before COVID. I asked Mr. Mike Briggler to take on the task of getting the band back together, so to speak, in addition to soliciting new people to join. We had a few general meetings in the cry room to discuss all the usual things: how many ushers do we need for each mass, what are the general responsibilities, who takes which specific responsibilities, and other things like that.

In the course of our discussion, the question of our safety and security at our masses came up. I told the ushers that I wasn't sure what our diocesan policy permits us to do. So I went and spoke with a diocesan official and came back to the group a month later: Bishop Taylor's policy is that no person may bring a firearm into church unless they are a law enforcement officer on duty. Not just a law enforcement officer, but a law enforcement officer on duty. With the crime at Annunciation in Minnesota last month, the question of private, armed security is coming up again with renewed vigor, but our diocese does not permit that. I realize that this may be disappointing for some people, but the material point is that we can't have armed security.

After a year of experience under their belt, however, the usher team is devising a few other security measures for our safety. Before each mass, the usher team will bring out a security bag, which will otherwise be kept under lock and key. The bag will contain three things. 1) a LifeLite; a LifeLite is a non-lethal contraption that looks like a flashlight but which shoots pepper balls accurately and at high speed, incapacitating any assailant. 2) The bag will have a security badge that is integrated with the school's new Centigix system. You may have noticed the small white box above the doors from the nave into the vestibule and similar boxes under the two speakers; those are a part of this new security system. In a worst case scenario, one of the ushers inside the nave here would use the badge to send a signal to the white boxes; this will automatically contact all Conway County Emergency Management and 911 services: Morrilton Police Department, the Sheriff's office, EMT services, and the fire department would all respond, and the badge's signal, triangulated by the three white boxes, would give them the location of the badge-holder. The usher team has also been discerning whether some or all of the doors from the vestibule to the outside should be locked once mass starts, and even whether some or all of the doors from the nave into the vestibule should be locked. There have been strong (but respectful) opinions in different directions, and I'm sure you also may have your own thoughts on what the best practice should be. Each of the options discussed presents certain benefits and certain drawbacks. We are trying our best to think through worst case scenarios and the optimal ways to keep our people safe, whether they are here in the nave or in the cry room. 3) In the event of weather sirens going off, the bag will also have a key that would allow the congregation to get into the tornado-proof safe-room at the elementary school next door.

I am very grateful to all our ushers for their service and to Mike Briggler for his leadership - they do a very fine job for us! If you have questions, please let me or Mike know.

## RAFFLE TICKET CLASS COMPETITION

All families are encouraged to help sell tickets to improve your child's classes' chances of winning.
